- Either electronically or on paper.
- All of our electronic devices that may store your data are locked by password, fingerprint readers, retina scanners and/or 'Face ID'.
- The 'cloud' storage services we use are similarly protected with high level security to recognised international standards.
- Any paperwork (which is kept to a minimum) is stored in a locked metal filing cabinet in a secure building.

- There is no plan nor need to share your information.
- This will remain in perpetuity.
- The only people who can view your data is ourselves, and of course you if you request it – which you can do at any time.
